In this UPDATE: Concert Attire

All concert attire that was ordered for the students and been received and sorted by bands. The students will receive all of their items tomorrow in class.

IT IS EXREMELY IMPORTANT THAT ALL STUDENTS RECEIVING NEW ITEMS TAKE THEM HOME TOMORROW so that you can have alterations done in a timely manner.

All dresses and pants are "unfinished" and will need to be hemmed. When alterations to the hemline are made be sure that the person doing the alterations understands that NONE OF THE MATERIAL MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE GARMENT!

Students in Concert Band (5th hour band) and Concert Winds (1st hour band) will need their concert attire for the Spaghetti Supper on November 11. You will need to get any alterations done prior to that date. If you plan to have the alterations done by a professional seamstress or tailor, you need to get the garment to them immediately in order to have it back in time for the performance.

Students in Wind Ensemble will need to have their garments ready for the performance at Chiddix on November 7. If you plan to have alterations done by a professional seamstress or tailor, you will need to get the garment to them immediately to have it back in time for the performance.

Proper care for your concert attire

DRESSES: may be washed on gentle cycle with mild detergent and cold water. Hang to dry.

TUXES

- Pants and Jackets should be dry cleaned after each performance to avoid the garment having a permanent odor.
- Shirts should be laundered after every performance. The shirts will last longer if the students wear a plain white t-shirt under the shirt. Most of the shirts will require some sort of stain remover / stain fighter on the collar area of the shirt to avoid permanent discoloration of the collar.
